#### INVITATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR DIRECT ENTRY ADMISSION TO ORDINARY DIPLOMA PROGRAMS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2017/2018

Water Institute (WI) is fully registered by the National Council for Technical Education (NACTE) and its Programmes are fully accredited by NACTE. The Institute invites applications for three years program direct entry admission to **ORDINARY DIPLOMA PROGRAMS** for the academic year 2017/18 (studies shall begin on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2017).

#### Admission requirements for the following Ordinary Diploma Programs:

##### (1) Water Supply and Sanitation Engineering

- (a) Holder of Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics/ Engineering Science and Chemistry; or
- (b) Holder of OCSE with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics and Physics/ Engineering Science AND holder of National Vocational Award (NVA) level 3 in a field related to Civil Engineering or Water Resources Engineering.

##### (2) Hydrology and Meteorology

- (a) Holder of Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics/ Engineering Science and Geography; or
- (b) Holder of OCSE with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics and Physics/ Engineering Science AND holder of National Vocational Award (NVA) level 3 in a field related to Civil Engineering or Water Resources Engineering.

##### (3) Hydrogeology and Water-Well Drilling

- (a) Holder of Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics/ Engineering Science and Geography; or
- (b) Holder of OCSE with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics and Physics/ Engineering Science AND holder of National Vocational Award (NVA) level 3 in a field related to Civil Engineering or Water Resources Engineering.

##### (4) Irrigation Engineering

- (a) Holder of Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics, Physics/ Engineering Science and Agricultural Science or Chemistry; or
- (b) Holder of OCSE with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics and Chemistry or Agricultural Science AND holder of National Vocational Award (NVA) level 3 in a field related to Agricultural Science or Irrigation Engineering.

##### (5) Water Quality Laboratory Technology

- (a) Holder of Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education (OCSE) with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics, Chemistry and Biology; or
- (b) Holder of OCSE with four passes in non-religious subjects including a minimum pass of D grade in the following subjects: Mathematics and Chemistry or Biology AND holder of National Vocational Award (NVA) level 3 in a field related to Water Quality Technology.
