YEAR 2026/2027**

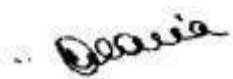
I am pleased to inform you that you have been selected for admission to the **Water Institute**, where you will undertake a three-year Ordinary Diploma Course Program in your chosen field.

2. Upon successfully completing the first year studies in the 2026/2027 academic year, you will earn a **Basic Technician Certificate** and qualify to advance to the second year in 2027/2028. If you complete the second year successfully, you will attain a **Technician Certificate** and will be promoted to the third-year studies in 2028/2029. Upon successfully finishing the third year, you will be awarded an **Ordinary Diploma**.

3. The registration requirements are as follows:

- i. Original and certified true copies of your certificates of secondary education (certified by a recognized advocate/court)
- ii. Original and certified true copies of your birth certificate (certified by a recognized advocate/court)
- iii. Submission of four recent colored passport-size
- iv. Filled Acceptance and Declaration form
- v. Duly filled and signed medical report
- vi. Proof of Payment
- vii. Departmental Requirement: A3-Drawing Board, Dark Blue Overalls, White Laboratory coat, non-programmable calculator (recommended CASIO f(x)-991 MS) and Gumboots (**All Available at Water Institute**)

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR YEAR 2026/2027 DIPLOMA STUDENTS

1.0 ACCOMMODATION

Due to the limited availability of accommodation at the Institute, priority will be given to students with disabilities, those from up- country, female students and first year students. Students who are granted accommodation on campus must pay **TZS 300,000/=** for the entire academic year, and the given amount should be paid in the beginning of the first semester. The Institute will provide a bed and a mattress, but students must bring the additional personal items as listed below:

- i. Pillow, Bed sheets and a towel;
- ii. Mosquito net;
- iii. Bucket of 10 or 20 liters;
- iv. Enough pocket money for personal expenses (e.g. for buying food, hygiene goods and stationery).

2.0 STUDY COSTS

As a diploma student, you will be required to pay an annual fee of **TZS 1,220,000/=** (One million, two hundred and twenty thousand shillings only) to cover the cost of your studies. The following table outlines the distribution of fee payment (*to be paid through a generated control number*).

3.0 DRESSING CODE

The Institute does not enforce a standard uniform; however, students are expected to dress appropriately and respectfully at all times both on campus and when representing the Institute in formal academic activities such as study tours, industrial training and field attachments.

4.0 MEDICAL COSTS

The Institute has a dispensary that offers medical consultancies and treatment for common illnesses. Each student is required to contribute **TZS 10,000** at the start of both first and second semester to support medical care expenses. This fee is **non-refundable**.

For medical conditions beyond the Institutes dispensary's capacity, students are referred to **certified Government Hospitals** in Dar es Salaam. Additionally, students without medical insurance **must pay TZS 50,400** at the beginning of each academic year to access health insurance coverage through National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF).



5.0 DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

Each student is required to cover the costs of department specific materials, as determined by their respective department. All necessary items **will be available for purchase at the Institute**, with prices detailed in the table below.

6.0 LIBRARY FEE

Students have to pay an annual library fee of **TZS 10,000** (Ten thousand only) for Library membership. Access to library services and facilities will strictly be limited to those who have paid the fee.

7.0 CAUTION MONEY

All new students are required to deposit **TZS 40,000** (forty thousand shillings) as **collateral security**, which will be used to cover the cost of lost or damaged Institute property. This deposit is **non-refundable**.

8.0 IDENTITY CARD

This requirement applies to all new students. Each student must pay **TZS 15,000** (fifteen thousand shillings) for issuance of a student identity card.

9.0 STUDENTS' UNION MEMBERSHIP FEE

The **Water Institute Students' Organization (WISO)** is the official student union at the institute. As a registered student, you automatically become a member. First-year students must pay a **non-refundable membership fee of TZS 20,000** (twenty thousand shillings), while continuing students contribute TZS **15,000** (fifteen thousand shillings) annually at the beginning of the first semester.

10.0 STUDENTS' SPORTS AND GAMES FEE

All students are required to participate in **sports, games and physical exercises**, including **inter-colleges competitions** to promote physical health and talents development. To support these activities, each student is obliged to pay **TZS 15,000** (fifteen thousand shillings) only at the beginning of each academic year.

11.0 REPORTING DATE

The orientation and registration week for September Intake 2026 new students will start on the **26th of October, 2026**. You are expected to **arrive at the Institute on that date and not earlier**. The first semester

studies will commence on **November 02, 2026**. Students arriving **more than two weeks** after the start of the semester **will not be accepted**, resulting in the **termination** of their admission.

13.0 PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

STEP 1:

- i. Connect your device with Internet (Smart Phone or Laptop/Computer);
- ii. In address bar type <https://sims.waterinstitute.ac.tz>.

STEP 2:

LOGIN TO YOUR SIMS ACCOUNT FOR NEWCOMER

Use your form IV index number as your **username (example: S1234/0042/2024)** and **surname** in capital letters as **password (example: KAPINGA)** for the first time. Change password once you are logged into the system.

STEP 3:

- i. After you are successfully logged in, Click Payment Menu on the left side then click Create Invoice.
- ii. After that Click Create Payment, then Click Fee Structure, then fill in the form to preview Invoice and select all options item required.
- iii. Then Click Preview Invoice button to load invoice and select options.
- iv. After that Click Create Invoice button, System will generate Invoice number, which will be used in Payment.
- v. You must submit original pay-in slip of the Bank/service provider as evidence that you have paid fees and other financial dues to the Institute.
- vi. You can pay the annual fees and other financial dues at once at the beginning of the first semester or in three installments, as described in the joining instructions.
- vii. You will not be accepted if you do not submit evidence of payments on the date you arrive at the Institute.
