I am pleased to inform you that you have been selected to join Water Institute (WI) to pursue the Bachelor's Degree program in.....

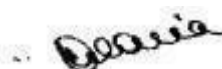
This is either a three- or four-year program, as approved by TCU, depending on entry requirements.

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR YEAR 2026/2027 BACHELOR STUDENTS

1.0 ACCOMMODATION

The Institute has very limited accommodation available for a few Ordinary Diploma students. For Bachelor's degree students, you are advised to find your own accommodation.

2.0 TUITION FEES

As a privately sponsored student, you will be required to pay an annual fee of **TZS 1,655,000/=** (One million six hundred fifty-five thousand shillings only), which will be used to cover study expenses. **Table 1** below stipulates the fee payment distribution and deadline for payment. *(To be paid through a generated control number).*

NB: All payments found in **Table 1** should be paid through the control number generated from the Student Information Management System (SIMS).

3.0 DRESSING

The Institute does not have a standard (uniform) dress, but students are expected to dress respectably at all times when they are at the Institute and when going out under the name of the Institute in other formal academic activities. Therefore, every student is obliged to pay **TZS 20,000/=** (twenty thousand shillings) for a Water Institute T-Shirt for all official occasions and events.

4.0 MEDICAL COSTS

The Institute has a dispensary that offers medical consultations and treatment for common illnesses. Each student is required to contribute **TZS 10,000/=** (Ten thousand shillings only) at the start of both the first and second semesters to support medical care expenses. This fee is **non-refundable**.

For medical conditions beyond the Institute's dispensary's capacity, students are referred to **certified Government Hospitals** in Dar es Salaam. Additionally, students without medical insurance **must pay TZS 50,400/=** (Fifty thousand and four hundred shillings only) at the beginning of each academic year to access health insurance coverage through the National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF).

5.0 DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

Each student is required to cover the costs of departmental specific materials, as determined by their respective department. All necessary items will be available for purchase at the Institute, with prices detailed in Table 2 below.

6.0 LIBRARY FEE

Students have to pay an annual library fee of **TZS 10,000/=** (Ten thousand only) for Library membership. Access to library services and facilities will strictly be limited to those who have paid the fee.

7.0 CAUTION MONEY

This applies to new students. Each student shall be required to deposit **TZS 40,000/=** (Forty thousand only) as collateral security that shall be used to recover lost or damaged Institute property. This amount is **non- refundable**.

8.0 IDENTITY CARD

This applies to all new students. Each student will be required to bring four recent passport-size colour photographs and to pay **TZS 15, 000/=** (Fifteen thousand only) for the production of the student's identity card.

9.0 STUDENTS' UNION MEMBERSHIP FEE

There is a students' union known as the **“Water Institute Students' Organization”** (WISO). Your registration as a student of this Institute entitles you to automatic membership to this student union. You shall, therefore, be obliged to contribute to this organization by paying a non-refundable membership fee of **TZS 20,000/=** (Twenty thousand only) for first-year students. Continuing students will pay an annual contribution of **TZS 15,000/=** (Fifteen thousand only) at the beginning of the first semester of every year.

10.0 STUDENTS' SPORTS AND GAMES FEE

All students are required to participate in **sports, games and physical exercises**, including **inter-college competitions** to promote physical health and talent development. To support these activities, each student is obliged to pay **TZS 15,000** (fifteen thousand shillings) only at the beginning of each academic year.

11.0 REPORTING DATE

The orientation and registration week for September Intake 2026 new students will start on the **26th of October, 2026**. You are expected to **arrive at the Institute on that date and not earlier**. The first semester studies will commence on **02nd November, 2026**. Arrival beyond two weeks from the semester start date will result in non-acceptance and cancellation of admission.

13.0 PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

STEP 1:

- i. Connect your device to the Internet (smartphone or Laptop/Computer);
- ii. In the address bar, type <https://sims.waterinstitute.ac.tz>.

STEP 2:

LOG IN TO YOUR SIMS ACCOUNT FOR NEWCOMERS

Use your Form IV index number as your **username (Example: S1234/0042/2024)** and your surname in capital letters as your **password (example: KAPINGA)** for the first time. Change your password once you log in to the system.

STEP 3:

- i. After you are successfully logged in, click Payment Menu on the left side, then click Create Invoice.
- ii. After that, click Create Payment, then click Fee Structure, then fill in the form to preview the invoice and select all required options.
- iii. Then click the Preview Invoice button to load the invoice and select options.
- iv. After that, click the Create Invoice button. The system will generate an invoice number, which will be used in Payment.
- v. You must submit the original pay-in slip of the Bank/service provider as evidence that you have paid fees and other financial dues to the Institute.
- vi. You can pay the annual fees and other financial dues at once at the beginning of the first semester or in three instalments, as described in the joining instructions.
- vii. You will not be accepted if you do not submit the evidence of payment on the date you arrive at the Institute.
