2. Upon the successful completion of the first-year studies in 2023/2024 you will attain the qualification of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA4) and will be promoted to undertake second-year studies in 2024/2025. If you will complete successfully the second-year studies in 2024/2025 you will attain the qualification of Technician Certificate (NTA5) and will be promoted to undertake third-year studies in 2025/2026. If you will complete successfully the third-year studies, you will attain the qualification of an Ordinary Diploma (NTA6).

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR YEAR 2023/2024 DIPLOMA STUDENTS

1.0 ACCOMMODATION

Accommodations at the Institute are limited; the priority will be given to students with disabilities, up-country students, female students and first year students. Those who secure accommodation at the Institute Campus will be required to pay a rent of **TZS 300,000/** for the whole year in the beginning of semester one. The Institute will provide you with a bed and a mattress. You will be required to come with the following items;

- i. Pillow, Bed sheets and a towel;
- ii. Mosquito net;
- iii. Bucket of 10 or 20 liters;
- iv. Enough pocket money for personal; expenses (e.g. for buying hygiene goods and stationery).

2.0 STUDY COSTS

As a diploma student, you will be required to pay an annual fee of **TZS 1,215,000** (One million and Two Hundred and Fifteen Thousand shillings only) which will be used to cover studying expenses. The table below stipulates the fee payment distribution.

3.0 DRESSING

The Institute does not have a standard (uniform) dress, but students are expected to dress respectably at all times when they are at the Institute and when going out under the name of the Institute in other formal academic activities such as study tours, industrial/field practical training attachment, etc.

4.0 MEDICAL COSTS

The Institute has a dispensary that provides medical consultancies and treatment of common diseases. Every student is required to pay **TZS 10,000** (ten thousand) at the beginning of the first semester and the same amount at the beginning of the second semester which is contribution toward cost of medical care. The money is **not refundable**. Any medical cases that cannot be attended by the Institute dispensary are referred to competent Government Hospitals in the City of Dares Salaam. The students who do not have Medical insurance **MUST** pay **TZS. 50,400/=** (fifty thousand four hundred shillings only) for health insurance at the beginning of every academic year.

5.0 DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

Each student has to bear the costs of departmental requirements according to the department as shown below;

6.0 LIBRARY FEE

Students have to pay an annual library fee of **TZS 10,000** (Ten thousand only) for Library membership. Access to the use of library facilities and services will strictly be limited to those who have paid this fee.

7.0 CAUTION MONEY

This applies to new students. Each student shall be required to deposit **TZS 40,000** (Forty thousands) as a collateral security that shall be used to recover lost or damaged Institute property. This amount is non-refundable.

8.0. IDENTITY CARD

This applies to all new students. Each student shall be required to bring four recent passport size colour photographs, and to pay **TZS 15,000** (fifteen thousand) for the production of the student's identity card.

9.0 STUDENTS' UNION MEMBERSHIP FEE

There is a students' union known as “**Water Institute Students' Organization**” (WISO). Your registration as a student of this Institute entitles you to automatic membership to this student union. You shall, therefore, be obliged to contribute to this organization by paying a non-refundable membership fee of **TZS 20,000** (Twenty thousands only) for the first year students. Continuing students will pay annual contribution of **TZS 15,000** (fifteen thousand only) at the beginning of first semester in every year.

12.0 PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

STEP 1:-

1. Connect your device with Internet (Smart Phone or Laptop);
2. In address bar type <https://sims.waterinstitute.ac.tz>.

STEP 2: LOGIN TO YOUR SIMS ACCOUNT

FOR NEW COMER

Use your form IV index number as your **username** and SURNAME in capital as **password** for the first time. Change password once you logged in to the system.

STEP 3:

After successfully logged in, Click Payment Menu in the left side then click Create Invoice.

After Click Create Payment, Click Fee Structure then fill in the form to preview Invoice and select all options item required.

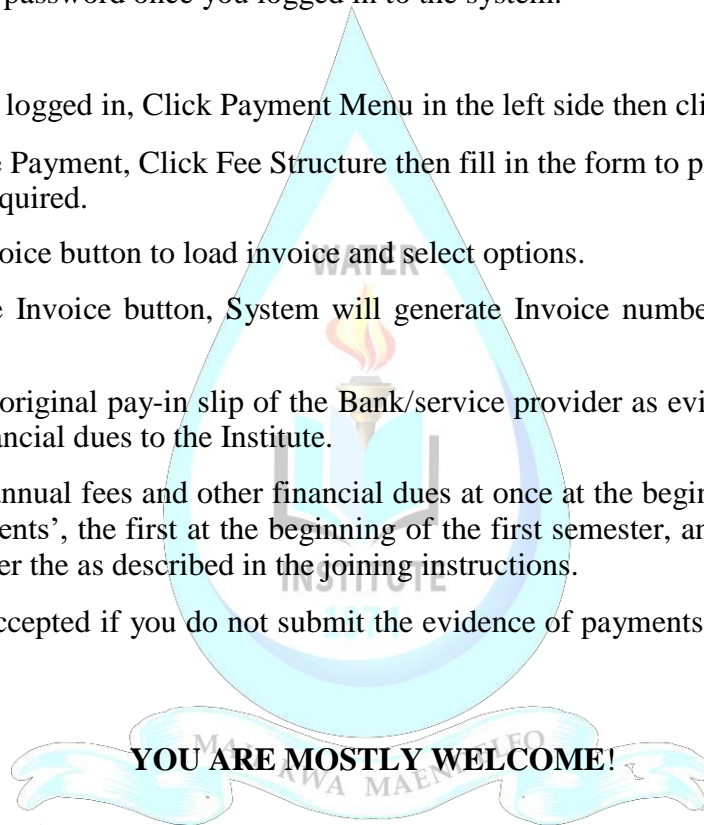
Click Preview Invoice button to load invoice and select options.
